VISIT WALES recommends the <u>HEART OF WALES TRAIN LINE</u> which takes "a scenic, meandering route through the beautiful green hillsides of Powys".

It passes <u>THE PALES HISTORIC MEETING HOUSE</u> built in 1717 "the oldest Quaker Meeting House in continuous use in Wales" The new <u>HEART OF WALES TRAIL</u> - is a "225km hiking route that shadows the tracks, wending between stations and through miles of wonderful Welsh countryside" opened in 2019.
